When Law Enforcement Arrives...What Should You Do?

We all hope that we never have to be part of an active shooter situation. However, if you are, at some point you are likely to encounter law enforcement as you escape from danger. What should you expect from the officers who arrive and how should you respond?

Law enforcement officers:

- **Usually, will arrive in teams of 2 or 4**
- **May wear regular uniforms or external bulletproof vests, Kevlar helmets, and other tactical equipment**
- **May be armed with rifles, shotguns, and handguns**
- **May use pepper spray or tear gas to control the situation**
- **May shout commands and may push individuals to the ground for their safety**

When coming into contact with officers in a situation like this, the biggest thing to remember is that you do not want to be mistaken for the shooter. To accomplish this:

- **Put down any items in your hands (for example, bags or jackets) so that they are not mistaken for a weapon**
- **Immediately raise hands and spread fingers**
- **Keep hands visible at all times so as not to be perceived to be going for a weapon**
- **Avoid making quick movements toward officers which can be viewed as attacking them**
- **Avoid holding onto the officers for safety**
- **Remain calm and follow officers' instructions**
- **Avoid pointing, screaming, or yelling**
- **Do not stop to ask officers for help or direction when evacuating, just proceed in the direction from which the officers are coming**

Remember the officers' mission is to eliminate the threat. You do not want to impede them from doing this, nor to be perceived to be the threat. However, if you have the following important information, you should provide it to one of the officers:

- **Location of the active shooter**
- **Number of shooters, if more than one**
- **Physical description of the shooter(s)**
- **Number and type of weapons held by the shooter(s)**
- **Number of potential victims at the location**
