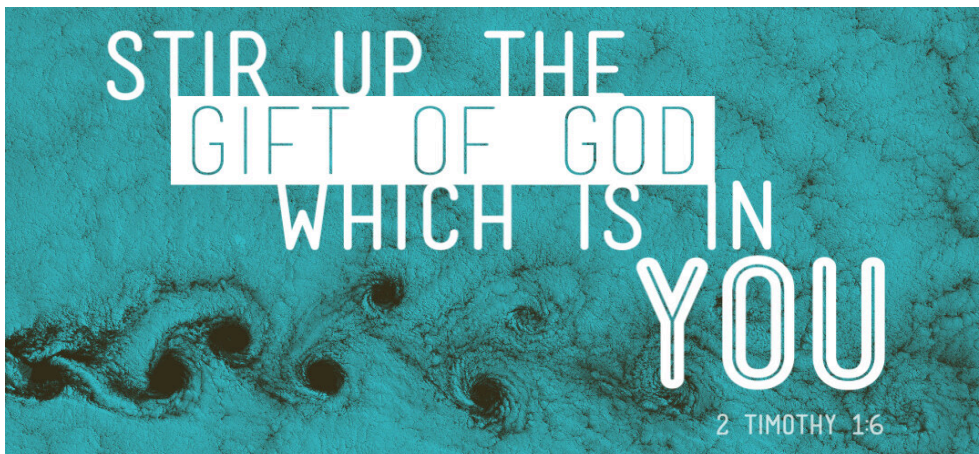
Stay In Your Own Lane

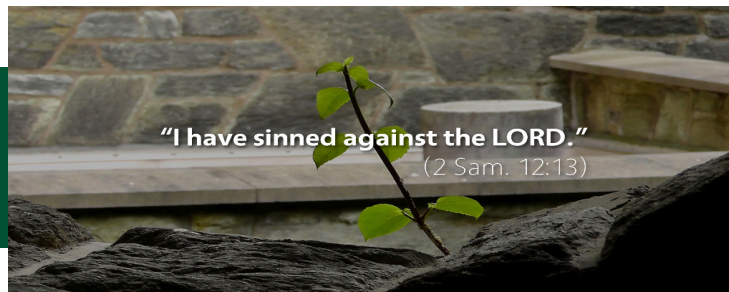
All boxes are due back by April 28
